Safety System Accreditation, COR 2019 & Excellence Program

6.1 William Roy - MOLTSD - Supporting Ontario Safe Employers

William introduced himself as a northern guy growing up in Sudbury. Worked for Dufferin construction in road and bridge projects in early years and became inspector for MOL. Currently he is now in the director role in the prevention office. He mentioned that the Excellence Program is voluntary and intended to be national.

Highlight of his presentation included: accreditation; employer recognition criteria; verification process; financial and non-financial incentives; and remaining in good standing with the MLTSD. The program was launched on November 22, 2019.

Highlight of his presentation included: a flexible program options; alignment with WSIB program; 36 topics (Foundation -10, Intermediate – 17, and Advance -9); alignment between the H & S Excellence Program and MOLTSD accreditation – from awareness to excellence; the journey and rebate on premium.
